### CONNECTION HELPS US LOVE LIKE JESUS

I have always been fascinated by Legos. When I was in 1<sup>st</sup> grade I spent most of my recess time building airplanes, cars, and intricate buildings to house them. Even as an adult, I love going to Lego Land at the Mall of America. It amazes me how they can take something as simple as a Lego and connect millions of them together to make something like a 40 foot tall spaceship or a life-sized stormtrooper from Star Wars. At the mall they have huge containers overflowing with individual Legos that are full of potential, just waiting for a creative kid to come along and put them together to make something awesome!

Humans aren't all that different from Legos, we come in all shapes, colors, and sizes. But most importantly, we are capable of great things when we are connected to each other. Connection is something that we all desire. We don't all desire it in the same quantity, some of us only have a couple connectors on our lego and some of us have room for many connection points. But deep down we all need quality connection.

In John 15:9-13 Jesus says, "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." Jesus sums up the law in this simple but hard to achieve command. It takes a lot of love and care for another person to be willing to lay down your life for them. The kind of love and care that are only likely to develop from being in genuine, intimate, and faith-connected relationship with others.

I would like to encourage each of you to find a genuine connection point at CrossRoads. Just showing up for Sunday morning service does not give you an opportunity for this level of connection. Try joining one of our Connection Groups, try attending a Bible Study, or ask about where you might be a good fit for serving on one of our ministry teams like Hospitality or Awana. Finding the right opportunity to be connected to others will help you begin to experience, and share with others, the love that Jesus is talking about. I believe that through our connection to each other God is capable of creating something truly magnificent!

## CHILDREN'S MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS

Children's Ministry at CRC is kicking off this Sunday, September 11<sup>th</sup>. We are so excited to have your kids in our Children's Ministry!

#### Here is what we will be offering on Sunday mornings:

Children's Church:	Ages 4 years to 2 <sup>nd</sup> grade
Sunday School:	Ages 4 years to 6 <sup>th</sup> grade

**Children's Church** will be dismissed from the service before the sermon and will be escorted down to Redwood. During Children's Church they will spend the rest of the service time learning Bible stories, singing praise songs and hymns, making crafts and other activities that point them to Jesus. This year we are using a curriculum from RaiseUpFaith entitled "One Story". This curriculum's goal is to teach kids how each story in scripture connects to God's big story, and ultimately points to Jesus.

Families are encouraged to head to Lakeside after the service to pick up their kids following the service and enjoy a church wide fellowship time before heading off to Sunday School at 10:30 am.


Sunday School will continue with Year 2 of Generations of Grace. This curriculum takes your child through the entire Bible in 3 years. Year 2 we will be focusing on the Books Deuteronomy through Esther. Each family will receive a Family Devotional which contains weekly devotions (5 daily devotions) that coincide with the lessons from the Teacher Book. Each devotion contains a brief lesson, application questions, and discussion topics to talk through as a family.
